

**Lambertville Community Advisory Team
Meeting Highlights
September 14, 2020**

Update from last meeting:

The design vetting process for the Police Site Redevelopment was the topic for both the Design Vetting Subcommittee and the Community Engagement Subcommittee. The Design Vetting Team gathered images to visually demonstrate the components of the draft concept plan; the Community Engagement Team created a communications outreach plan.

Community feedback to the Redevelopment Plan will be solicited by a community wide survey and on Saturday September 26,2020 CAT will host a Virtual Design Meeting via Zoom. Community members can register through the CAT's [webpage](#) and through this [direct link](#).

Redevelopment Concept Plan Presentation

Emily Goldman and Michael Hanrahan presented a site map that incorporated CAT feedback from the CAT's 9/3 meeting. Primarily using images submitted by the CAT, they also discussed the components of the concept plan -architecture, articulation, materials, windows, rooftops, garage screening, ground level terrace, roadway screening and plantings. Images will be used to gather community feedback on each component through both a community-wide survey and the 9/26 public design vetting/charette meeting. Input from the CAT has been solicited to narrow the images to 3-5 per category. The survey will follow the structure of the concept plan and include definitions of terms for clarity.

Upcoming Plans

- The environmental team will conduct a Q&A with Vince Mazzai from DEP.
- The CAT will present to City Council its work (including output from the 9/26 design vetting meeting and community wide survey, and recommendations regarding a Phase 1 study) at the 10/6 Council meeting.
- The Redevelopment Plan Survey will be posted on Friday, September 18, 2020
