STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE.

RESOLUTIONS.

<u>Resolution Number 164-2016</u>: A Resolution to Authorize the Mayor, City Attorney and City Clerk to Execute the Memorandum of Understanding Between City of Lambertville and Potential Redeveloper Kalian at Lambertville, LLC.

Mayor DelVecchio informed the members of the public present that the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Lambertville and potential redeveloper Kailian at Lambertville, LLC is for the old high school property located on Washington Street in the City. This memorandum of understanding will be used to help settle our COAH law suit and is the beginning stages of the redevelopment of the old high school property.
