- b. DOG AND CAT LICENSES are available for purchase starting Tuesday, January 2, 2018 at City Hall, 18 York Street. The fee for a spayed dog or cat is \$15. Licensing of dogs a requirement of the NJSA 4. A \$25 late fee imposed beginning March 1, 2018.
- c. PARKING PERMITS for those residing on metered streets will be available for purchase starting the week of December 26th at City Hall. The annual fee is \$45 for a Permanent Residential Parking Permit, \$60 for a Transferrable Permit, and \$25 for a Temporary Parking Permit.
